Service modifications

- Only certain medical visits can be made available at the clinic at this time. The Floating Hospital
 offers telehealth visits if your planned visit does not fall within current NYS COVID guidelines.
 Certain periods of time will be allotted to telehealth and in-person visits.
- In general, the following types of visits can be seen at the clinic:
 - Routine physicals for new and existing patients;
 - · Sick visits with pre-screening;
 - · Well child visits for children 0-5 requiring vaccinations; and
 - Routine dental visits for established patients (we are not seeing new patients at this time).
 - All behavioral Health visits have been converted to telehealth.

- COVID-19 testing offered by appointment only. Call 718-782-2240*150.

Clinic closures

- The Floating Hospital's main healthcare center in LIC will remain open with shortened hours: Monday-Thursday, 8:00AM to 5:30PM, Friday, 8:00AM to 5:00PM.
- The Floating Hospital's Queensbridge clinic is open Monday-Friday, 9:00AM to 5:00PM.
- The Floating Hospital's Astoria clinic is open Tuesday and Friday, 9:00AM to 5:00PM, by appointment only. Call 718-784-2240 to schedule. Our Goodwill clinic remains closed.
